Welcome to Knightswood Library



Once you come in press this button to open the automatic doors. It is on the right.



This will open the door saying "way in"



On entering the library you will find the information desk.



Sometimes there might not be a member of staff at the desk but if help is needed, someone will come to help as soon as they can.

A member of library staff will be wearing a badge like this and will be able to help you.



To take out books you will need a library card. To get a library card you need to bring something with your name and address on it to the library. You will also need to fill in this form. Staff will be able to help you.



There are also toilets that can be used when at the library and can be used by anyone visiting.

These toilets are found at the entrance. Ask a member of staff for the key to use the toilet.



Knightswood Library can be busy on Wednesday at 10.30am – 11.30am, Thursday 1.30pm – 2.30pm & every day from 3pm – 5pm. We are also busy on a Saturday.
Children come to sing and play.

The fire alarm will be tested on a Wednesday between 9:30am and 10.30am.

Computers are available for use while at the Library. You can also use the free Wi-Fi.
